

Poly Diamond Court Maintenance Procedure

Preparing Courts for Play:

- 1. Dust mop or sweep courts with fine broom to remove any debris.
- Use a damp microfiber pad to clean court until the pad is not collecting dirt (may take 2-3 pads rinsing each as they get dirty).
- Let dry and apply dressing. Poly Glide, Inc. has various dressings to provide desired speed which will not harm the playing surface.
- 4. Sweep up dressing after playing.

Happy Shuffling!

Monthly Maintenance:

- 1. Mix solution of 2 oz. of Poly Court Neutralizer to a gallon of water. Use a 4 gallon mop bucket and blended fiber mop.
- 2. Spread liberally on the court and agitate with mop.
- 3. Rinse well with clean water.
- 4. Squeegee off any remaining water.
- 5. Use a clean damp microfiber pad to dry court.

Yearly Maintenance (Performed by Mitch Dean of Poly Diamond Systems):

- 1. Scrub courts thoroughly with propane powered hydra-diamond polishing machine.
- 2. Touch-up lines and numbers.
- 3. Re-polish with propane powered machine using 3000 grit diamond pads.
- 4. Re-densify. Heat densifier with propane powered polishing machine.
- 5. Apply Poly Ultra Spray Buff Treatment with 500 rpm buffer using 3m polish pad.
